Mabel found contentment in life because she found joy in simple things. Besides loving her children and grandchildren, she also loved Abraham Lincoln; her cat, Kringles; her Oldsmobile; the Lawrence Welk Show and the U.K. Basketball team. Mabel's enduring legacy is that she possessed the ability to see only the good in others and spent her life loving and serving people. A private service was held at her request.
